

Wildflowers were once called **earth stars** and together with artist Tom Jordan, I produced twelve prints in an edition of five, one for each of the twelve signs of the Zodiac. In keeping with the original inspiration, the colour of the stars represents the colours of wild flowers open at a particular time of year (See below). Star maps drawn using IAU and Sky and Telescope chart.
